



BRAHMATAL ITINERARY

Description:

Embark on an unforgettable journey through the snow-laden trails of the Brahmatal Trek, a perfect blend of adventure and serenity. Nestled in the Garhwal Himalayas, this 6-day trek offers stunning views of towering peaks like Trishul and Nanda Ghunti. Experience the thrill of walking through dense oak and rhododendron forests, pristine alpine meadows, and frozen lakes. With premium amenities, delicious meals, and expert guidance, Blue Magpie Adventures ensures your trek is comfortable, safe, and truly memorable.

DAY 1: DELHI TO DEHRADUN

We meet at Hazrat Nizamuddin station in Delhi at 2315hrs to catch the Kota Dehradun AC Express at 2350hrs.

DAY 2: DEHRADUN TO LOHAJUNG

The train will drop us at Dehradun railway station at 0545hrs. After a washroom break and tea break in Dehradun, we start our drive to Lohajung in Chamoli district at 0700hrs after some rest. We will stop for breakfast and a loo break on the way. We'll cross the beautiful hill towns of New Tehri, Srinagar, Rudraprayag and Karnaprayag during our bus journey. We will take another break for lunch and reach the quaint little village of Lohajung by 1730hrs.

Tea and biscuits on arrival followed by room allocation. This will be followed by soup and snacks in the evening. A magical night of bonding with the group over bonfire. A wholesome dinner and then we retire for the night. Overnight at a hotel in Lohajung.

DAY 3: LOHAJUNG TO GUJRENI

After breakfast, kickstart your trek with a scenic journey from Lohajung to Gujreni, covering approximately **4 km** in **4–5 hours**. The trail takes you through enchanting oak and rhododendron forests, with glimpses of bubbling streams and quaint hillside villages. The calmness of the surroundings grows as you climb higher, offering a refreshing retreat into nature. Gujreni, a serene campsite surrounded by towering trees, greets you with awe-inspiring views and the soothing whispers of nature. Reach Gujreni campsite by lunchtime. Tea, soup and snacks and a hearty meal to end the day under a sky full of stars.

DAY 4: GUJRENI TO TILANDI

Today's trek takes you from Gujreni to Tilandi, covering **5 km** in **5–6 hours**. The trail gradually ascends through lush forests before opening up to expansive meadows with panoramic Himalayan views. Along the way, enjoy the tranquility of untouched nature and spot vibrant alpine flora. Tilandi, your campsite for the night, offers stunning vistas of snow-capped peaks and endless skies. Relax in the crisp mountain air, enjoy a warm meal, and prepare for the adventures that lie ahead.

DAY 5: TREK FROM TILANDI TO BRAHMATAL VIA BRAHMATAL TOP

This exciting day covers **7 km** in **6–7 hours**, taking you to the stunning Brahmatal Top and then descending to the serene Brahmatal Lake. The trail climbs steadily through snow-laden paths, offering breathtaking views of Mt. Trishul and Mt. Nanda Ghunti. At Brahmatal Top, soak in the majestic 360-degree panorama of the Himalayan ranges. Afterward, descend to Brahmatal Lake, nestled amidst snow-covered surroundings. Camp here for the night, enjoying the tranquility and beauty of this alpine haven.

DAY 6: BRAHMATAL TO LOHAJUNG

The final day of your trek covers **9 km** in **6–7 hours**, as you descend from Brahmatal to Lohajung. The trail winds through dense oak and rhododendron forests, with occasional clearings offering farewell glimpses of the towering Himalayan peaks. The descent is gentle yet rewarding, allowing you to relish the changing landscapes and serene mountain vibes. Upon reaching Lohajung, celebrate the successful completion of your trek with your team, reflecting on the unforgettable memories created over the past days. Overnight at hotel in Lohajung.

DAY 7: LOHAJUNG TO DEHRADUN

After breakfast at the hotel, begin your drive back to Dehradun, covering around **200 km** in **7–8 hours**. Enjoy the scenic views as you descend through the hills, passing by charming villages and lush valleys. Upon reaching Dehradun, you'll have some time to relax and unwind before

boarding the Mussoorie Express to Delhi at 2120hrs. The journey to Delhi marks the end of your unforgettable Brahmatal trek, filled with memories of the majestic Himalayas and pristine landscapes.

DAY 8: REACH DELHI

Reach Old Delhi Railway station by 0720hrs in the morning. Trip ends.

INCLUSIONS:

- All travel from Delhi and back to Delhi by AC train
- All travel from Dehradun and back to Dehradun by road (by non AC vehicle)
- All arrangements for staying in tents while on the trip
- All meals from breakfast on Day 2 to lunch on Day 7.
- Sanctuary fee / royalty / permits where applicable.
- Trek insurance
- All trekking arrangements - experienced guiding team, camp staff, cook, etc.
- Porters/mules for personal baggage up to 12 kg.

EXCLUSIONS:

- Airfares and Airport Taxes
- Items of personal clothing.
- Expenses of a personal nature like laundry, beverages and snacks.
- Only trek insurance is part of the package, no other type of insurance is covered in the package.
- Tips for Guide, Cook & Porters.
- Any costs arising out of unforeseen circumstances such as bad weather, landslides, road conditions and any other circumstances beyond our control.
- Single supplement (Separate tent and room in hotel): Rs. 6,000

Booking & Payment Conditions: -

At least 50% of the payment should be made in advance at the time of booking to confirm your spot. The remaining 50% must be paid at least 15 days before the date of commencement of travel.

Cancellation Terms

1. An admin fee of Rs. 1200 per person will be deducted in case of cancellation by the customer irrespective of the date of cancellation.
2. 100% of the total amount paid, minus the admin fee, will be refunded within 10-15 business days from the date of conclusion of the trip if the travel plan is cancelled by the customer 45 days or more prior to the date of commencement of travel. Alternatively, you can go for another trip within the next 120 days from the date of cancellation by paying the balance amount or getting a refund of the excess amount and avoid paying the admin fee.
3. 75% of the total amount paid, minus the admin fee will be refunded within 10-15 business days from the date of conclusion of the trip if the travel plan is cancelled by the customer 30 days or more prior to the date of commencement of travel. Alternatively, you can go for another trip within the next 120 days from the date of cancellation by paying the balance amount or getting a refund of the excess amount and avoid paying the admin fee.
4. 50% of the total amount paid, minus the admin fee will be refunded within 10-15 business days from the date of conclusion of the trip if the travel plan is cancelled by the customer 15 days or more prior to the date of commencement of travel. Alternatively, you can go for another trip within the next 120 days from the date of cancellation by paying the balance amount or getting a refund of the excess amount and avoid paying the admin fee.
5. No money shall be refunded in case of cancellation of travel plan less than 15 days prior to the date of commencement of travel. Alternatively, you can go for another trip within the next 120 days from the date of cancellation by paying the balance amount or getting a refund of the excess amount. An admin fee of Rs. 1200 per person will be charged in this case.
6. 100% of the amount paid will be refunded to the customer in case of cancellation by Blue Magpie Adventures irrespective of the date of cancellation except in cases of cancellation due to unforeseen circumstances such as bad weather, landslides, road conditions and any other circumstances beyond our control. Alternatively, the customer has the option to avail the amount paid as credit for another trip within 365 days of cancellation by Blue Magpie Adventures plus an additional Rs. 3000 off on their next trip.
7. 100% of the amount paid minus an admin fee of Rs. 1200 per person will be credited to the customer for use for any trip in the near future within 120 days of cancellation by Blue Magpie Adventures in cases of cancellation due to unforeseen circumstances such

as bad weather, landslides, road conditions and any other circumstances beyond our control.
